### Winter Craft Night

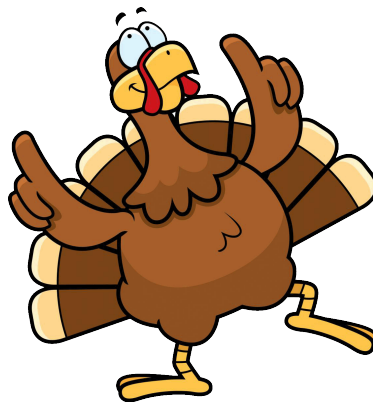
