 - a. Discussed the new law signed in California regarding State Funded Transportation. RSD already provides transportation. Cindy would like to go over Redding School District's Transportation Plan likely at the January 18, 2023 meeting
 - b. Per this group parents want an overnight Science Camp option, due to WES Camp being closed to rebuild after the CARR Fire. All Redding School sites will be attending a 2 ½ Day/overnight stay at Lassen Pines/Camp Unite, which will have a Park Ranger and Science Activities during their stay. The District will be sending out a Parent Survey to see how parents feel about Camp Unite (and its 1 hour distance from Redding vs a Science Camp ran by a County Office 3 hours away)
 - c. The WES Camp Board are looking for Donations to help fund the 3 million dollar shortfall to get the camp up and running by 23/24
